The meeting of the Capitalize Albany Corporation Governance Committee was held at 9:00 a.m., Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 21 Lodge Street, Albany, NY.

Chair Mark Sullivan called the meeting of the Capitalize Albany Corporation Governance Committee to order at 9:05 a.m.

Approval of Minutes for April 21, 2017 Governance Committee Meeting

The Committee reviewed the minutes of the April 21, 2017 meeting. Jeff Sperry made a motion for approval. John Harris seconded. The Committee agreed unanimously to approve the minutes.

Review of Board and Committee Appointments

The Committee reviewed and discussed the diverse slate of nominees received from the Board and Staff as a potential Board appointment. A potential appointee was chosen unanimously by the Committee. Staff will contact the individual about the nomination and the nominee will be recommended for Board approval at the next full Board meeting.

Staff informed the Committee that all seven members whose terms expire in 2017 have expressed interest in continuing their appointments.

Chair Sullivan informed the Committee that Michele Vennard has agreed to serve on the Audit Committee.

Personnel Policies

The Committee discussed enhancing the Corporation's employee benefit offerings in order to attract and retain the best employees. Staff reviewed the current employee benefits relating to short term disability, maternity and paternity leave. Staff and the Committee discussed three

quotes received from insurance companies regarding the enhancement of the Corporation's employee short-term disability benefits. The Committee and Staff discussed the plan analysis for each quote. The Committee recommended amending/enhancing the short term disability policy and maternity policy, and establishing a paternity leave policy.
